the said Cooper Turner is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and desires
to obtain supplies during the year 1881 from the said Jas J Darden for the amount
of Fifty five dollars and for taking the acknowledge and for recording this agreement
entitles the said Jas J Darden having an his part agreed to furnish said supplies to the
said Cooper Turner on his part and in consideration of the above provisions does
hereby grant a bill to the said Jas J Darden and his heirs to be made the year 1881
on the May 1st hand or on the last day of which he lives and I hereby receive my acceptance
as to this bill as contract for the amount aforesaid to him this year which has been
or was intended to have been expended and the said Cooper Turner binds himself
to due to deliver said Cooper above mentioned to Jas J Darden at his home in
by and before the 1st day of December 1881. This bill is granted under an Act of the
General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2^d 1878 intitled an act to secure

This Agreement made and entered into this 28th day of April 1881 between R P
Pope of the first part and Jas W Gray of the other part, witnesseth as follows: that
whereas the said Jas W Gray is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is
desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1881 from the said R P Pope for the
amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars, beyond which amount the said Jas
W Gray shall not go, and the said R P Pope having an his part agreed to furnish
said supplies to the said Jas W Gray on his part and in consideration of the
above provisions doth hereby grant a bill to the said R P Pope on all the expenses
which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands of which the said Jas W
Gray cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended
to have been expended. It is further agreed by the parties to this agreement that
the said R P Pope shall be first paid and satisfied after which the balance if any
shall be paid over to the said Jas W Gray. This bill is granted under an Act of
the General Assembly of Virginia April 2^d 1878 intitled an act to
