This Agreement made and entered into this 28th day of April 1881 between R. P. Pope of the first part and Mr. J. Scott of the other part, to witness as follows: that whereas the said Mr. J. Scott is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1881 from the said R. P. Pope for the amount of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars, beyond which amount the said Mr. J. Scott shall not go, and the said R. P. Pope having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, has the said Mr. J. Scott on his part and in consideration of the above provisions, cloth, huckly grain, &c, &c, to the said R. P. Pope all the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands of which the said Mr. J. Scott cultivates for the above amount of advances which have been or are intended to have been expended, now it is further agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said R. P. Pope shall be first paid and satisfied, after which the balance, if any shall be paid over to the said Mr. J. Scott. His sum is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 27th, 1871 entitled an act to secure the advance for agricultural purposes, to witness following signatures and seals,
