Wm. A. Myrick for the amount of Sixty Dollars beyond which amount the said
the said Huston Leigh shall not go, and the said Wm. A. Myrick having on his part agreed
to furnish said seedlings more the said Huston Leigh on his part and in consideration
of the above provisions doth hereby grant a lien to the said Wm. A. Myrick on
all the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands of which
the said Leigh cultivates for the above amount of six hundred dollars which has been
intended to have been expended. Now it is further agreed by the parties to this agreement
that the said Wm. A. Myrick shall be first paid and satisfied after which the
balance if any shall be paid over to the said Huston Leigh. This lien is granted
under an act of the general assembly of Virginia passed April 2/79 entitled
an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes within the following

to furnish said seedlings more the said Tom Boon on his part and in
consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a lien to the said
Wm. A. Myrick on all the crops which may be made during the year 1881
upon the lands of which the said Boon cultivates for the above amount of
five hundred dollars which has been intended to have been expended more it
