Myrick having on their part agreed to furnish said supplies more the said Simon Bryant on his part and in consideration of the above provisions doth hereby grant a lien to the said Wm. A. Myrick on all the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands of which the said Bryant cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended to have been expended more it is further agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said Wm. A. Myrick shall be first paid and satisfied after which the balance if any shall be paid over to the said Simon Bryant. This lien is granted under an act of the general assembly of Virginia of the 23rd of April 1793 entitled and act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes, Witness the foregoing signatures and seals.
