This Agreement made this 24th day of April in the year 1871, between J. W. Bornette of Southampton County, of the first part, and Lewis Mosher of Southampton County of the second part, of the State of Virginia, witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said J. W. Bornette is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Lewis Mosher shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said Lewis Mosher has agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said Lewis Mosher doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said J. W. Bornette during the present year, such money, provisions, fuel, and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Three hundred & twenty five dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the said J. W. Bornette to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said J. W. Bornette hereby gives and grants to the said Lewis Mosher a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton, during the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873, to wit: and enacted this 25th day of April 1871.

This Agreement made this 25th day of April in the year 1871, between Ephraim Ford of Southampton County, of the first part, and R. S. Pope of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Ephraim Ford is engaged in, or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said R. S. Pope shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said R. S. Pope has agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said R. S. Pope doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said E. Ford, during the present year, such money, provisions, fuel, and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Fourteen & no dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the said E. Ford to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said E. Ford hereby gives and grants to the said R. S. Pope a lien upon all crops that he may make on the lands which he has, or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton, during the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated.
