This Agreement made this 28th day of April in the year 1881 between Gilbert Pennie of Southampton County, of the first part, and Ben Evans, of Southampton County, of the second part, of the State of Virginia, Witnesses as follows, Whereas the said Gilbert Pennie is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and it is desired that the said Ben Evans should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which said Ben Evans has agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said Ben Evans doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Gilbert Pennie during the present year such money, provisions, fuel, hay, and other supplies not exceeding the sum of Forty two (\$42) dollars in amount, as may be needed to enable the said Gilbert Pennie to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year and the said Gilbert Pennie hereby gives and grants to the said Ben Evans a lien upon all crops that he may make in the hands which he has or may have in cultivation in the County of Southampton during the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Tobacco and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873, Witnesses aforesaid this 28th day of April 1881.

This Deed of Bargain & Sale made this 3rd day of March 1881 between Ephraim Beale and Nancy his wife of the County of Giles of West Virginia and John A. Keenan of the County of Southampton (both of the State of Virginia) witnesses with that the said Ephraim Beale and Nancy his wife of the first part grantors in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by the said John A. Keenan of the second part grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said grantors. They the said Ephraim Beale and Nancy his wife do grant Convey, bargain and sell with general warranty unto the said John A. Keenan the following real property, to wit, a certain parcel or lot of land situated in the town of Buchanan and bounded as follows, commencing at the south west corner of P. S. Lee lot near the Rail road Depot, said point being fifty feet from center of said road track, thence in a northerly direction along the said P. S. Lee and J. J. D. Butler's eastern boundaries, to W. A. Butler's lot about 93 feet thence in an easterly direction along said Butler's line (Southwest) and continuing in like direction 9 3/4 feet to corner in said Beale's lot thence in a Southwesterly direction 93 feet to S. Cabard & Rowan's rail road lands thence in a westerly direction
