This Agreement made this 28th day of April 1881 between J^{le} James & Co. of the one part, and Jno Blunt of the other part, witnesseth that to have the said Jno Blunt is engaged in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain advances in supplies from the said J^{le} James & Co. to the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars, beyond which limit the said Jno Blunt shall not go, and the said J^{le} James & Co. having agreed on this fact to furnish said amount of advances. Now the said Jno Blunt, on his part in consideration of the above premises doth hereby grant a lien to the said J^{le} James & Co. on all the crops made during the year 1881 on the lands in cultivation of which the said amount of advance may be incurred to have been expended. This lien is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April the 3^d 1873 entitled an Act to secure advances for Agricultural Purposes. Witness the following signatures,

This Deed made this 6th day of May 1881 between Samuel Thor Griffin of the first part, and H R Griffin trustee of the second part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges the said party of the first part doth grant and convey unto the said party of the second part all of his right title and interest in and to that certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton and known as the Redmon Cobb tract and bounded by the bounds of his deceased Elly Bryant const others containing elly four acres more or less and also all of his right and interest in and to the land belonging to the Estate of William Griffin deceased containing 2¹/₂ acres more or less and bounded by the land of his deceased wife Judkins Est and the Redmon Cobb tract. And the said party of the first part doth also sell, grant and convey unto the said party of the second part one brown horse to have and to hold the same in the aforementioned two tracts of land and the said brown horse to him and his heirs forever. In trust however to secure to James E Johnson the payment of one note for the sum of
