This Agreement, made this 25th day of March in the year 1871 between B. J. Johnson of the first part, and Barham & Pinner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia: Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said B. J. Johnson is engaged in, and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Barham & Pinner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Pinner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth that the said Barham & Pinner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said B. J. Johnson during the present year such money for various necessities and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of Three Hundred dollars in amount) as may be needed to enable the said B. J. Johnson to cultivate and gather his crops for which to be made the present year. And the said B. J. Johnson hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Pinner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops and to retain the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1870. Witness our hands this 25th day of March, 1871.
