

That the said Barham & Annex do hereby promise and agree to deliver and furnish to the said Washington Jones during the present year, such money provisions fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of twenty five dollars (\$25) dollars in amount as may be manifest to enable the said Washington Jones to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Washington Jones hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Annex a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit. Corn Potatoes Peas Runners Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. Now this Agreement witnesses that the said Barham & Annex do hereby promise and agree to deliver and furnish to the said Roy Riches during the present year such money provisions fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of \$300.00, thirty dollars in amount as may be manifest to enable the said Roy Riches to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Roy Riches hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Annex a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit. Corn Potatoes Peas Runners Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
