This Agreement made this 23^d day of March in the year 1823 between Daniel Smith of the first part and Beekham & Turner of the other part both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia, Whereas as before Whereas the said Daniel Smith is engaged in and about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Beekham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil which the said Beekham & Turner has agreed to do. Now this agreement witnesseth that the said Beekham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Daniel Smith during the present year, such monies provisions fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of two hundred & forty dollars in any one year may be useful to enable the said Daniel Smith to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Daniel Smith hereby gives and grants to the said Beekham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated, also Red Wax. This Agreement is made in presence of a list of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 9. 1823. Witness our hands this 23^d day of March 1823.

Now therefore, the said Barbara & Runner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Frank Wyck during the present year, such money, provisions, fertilizers and other
