of the first part and Barbara & Turner of the other part both of the County
of Southampton State of Virginia Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the
said Henry Hall is engaged in an is about to engage in the cultivation of
the soil and is desirous that the said Barbara & Turner shall during the
present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which
the said Barbara & Turner do hereby acknowledge. Now this agreement witnesseth
that the said Barbara & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance
and furnish to the said Henry Hall during the present year such money,
provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of one
hundred & fifty dollars or less in amount) as may be useful to enable
the said Henry Hall to cultivate and gather his crops so as to be
marketed the present year. And the said Henry Hall hereby gives and grants
to the said Barbara & Turner a lien upon all such Crops as he may
make the present year to wit Corn, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and
all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and
advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
This agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly
approved April 2 1873. Witness our hands this 26 day of March 1881.

as follows: Whereas the said Morris Mason is engaged in an is about
to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said
Barbara and Turner shall during the present year make certain
advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Barbara & Turner
do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said
Morris Mason during the present year such money, provisions
fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of forty five (45)
dollars in amount) as may be useful to enable the said Morris Mason
to cultivate and gather his crops so as to be marketed the present year.
And the said Morris Mason hereby gives and grants to the said Barbara
& Turner a lien upon all such Crops as he may make the present year
to wit, Corn, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in order
to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be
actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This agreement
is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of
Virginia approved April 2nd 1873. Witness our hands this 7th day of Feb 1881
