to receipt I hereby acknowledge the above mare and cattle are to be bound to the
said Burkham & Turner an infant December 1st 1881, from and during my bands and
such this 8th day of Feb 1881.

This Agreement made this 19th day of April in the year 1881 between John A
Story of the first part and Burkham & Turner of the other part of the County of
Southampton, State of Virginia. Witnesseth. Whereas, the said
John A Story is engaged in agriculture in the cultivation of the soil
and is desirous that the said Burkham & Turner shall during the present year
make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Burkham &
Turner agreed to do. Now this agreement witnesseth. That the said Burkham &
Turner doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said John
A Story during the present year such money provisions fertilizer and other
supplies (not exceeding the sum of One hundred & fifty dollars in amount)
as may be needful to enable the said John A Story to cultivate and gather his
crop proposed to be made the present year. And the said John A Story hereby
gives and grants to the said Burkham & Turner a bill upon all such crops
as he may make the present year to wit, Corn, Pudding, Peas, Beans, Cotton and
all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and
advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
This Agreement is made in accordance of a bill of the General Assembly
of Virginia approved April 9, 1873. Witness our hands this 19th day of April 1881
