 cow (Red Colly) and two yearlings for the sum of one Hundred & fifteen dollars
 the receipt I hereby acknowledge. The above mares and cattle are to be delivered to the
 said Barkham & Sumner on or before December 1st 1881. Given under my hand and

This Agreement made this 19th day of April in the year 1881 between John F.
 Story of the first part and Barkham & Sumner of the latter part of the County of
 Southampton State of Virginia Witnesses as follows: Whereas the said
 John F. Story is engaged in and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil
 and is desirous that the said Barkham & Sumner should during the present year
 make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which the said Barkham &
 Sumner have agreed to do. Now this Agreement Witnesseth that the said Barkham
 & Sumner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said John
 F. Story during the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers and other
 supplies (not exceeding the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars in amount)
 as may be needed to enable the said John F. Story to cultivate and gather his
 crops and for seeds to be made the present year. And the said John F. Story hereby
 gives and grants to the said Barkham & Sumner a lien upon all such crops
 as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and
 all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and
 advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated

This Agreement is made in pursuance of a contract of the General Assembly
 of Virginia, approved April 9, 1873. Witness our hands this 19th day of April 1881
