This Agreement made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1851 between Barham & Sumner  
of the first part and Smith Bynum of the other part both of the County of Southampton  
State of Virginia. Witness as follows: Whereas the said Smith Bynum is engaged in as  
is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said Barham & Sumner  
shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil,  
which the said Barham & Sumner have agreed to do. Now this agreement witnesseth  
that the said Barham & Sumner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish  
to the said Smith Bynum during the present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers  
and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of twenty (\$20) dollars in amount) as  
may be useful to enable the said Smith Bynum to cultivate and gather his crops  
proposed to be made the present year. And the said Smith Bynum hereby gives  
and grants to the said Barham & Sumner a lien upon all such crops as he may  
make the present year, to wit: Corn Fodder Peas Pumpkin Cotton and all other  
crops, in order to secure the payment of such supplies and advances as may  
be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in  
presence of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 5, 1853  
Witness our hands this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1851.

This Agreement made this 14<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year 1851 between John  
Wiggins of the first and Barham & Sumner of the other part both of the County  
of Southampton State of Virginia. Witness as follows: Whereas the said  
John Wiggins is engaged in as is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil,  
and is desirous that the said Barham & Sumner shall during the present year  
make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham  
& Sumner have agreed to do. Now this agreement witnesseth that the said  
Barham & Sumner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish  
to the said John Wiggins during the present year, such monies, provisions,  
fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of twenty (\$20) dollars and fifty  
cents in amount) as may be useful to enable the said John Wiggins  
to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And  
the said John Wiggins hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Sumner  
a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit:
