This Agreement made this 22 day of Feb in the year 1880 between William Aiter of the first part and Barham & Turner of the latter part both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia Witnesses as follows, Whereas the said William Aiter is engaged in or is about to be engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Barham and Turner have agreed to do. Now this agreement Witnesseth that the said Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said William Aiter during the present year such manure provisions fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of fifty dollars in amount as may be needed to enable the said William Aiter to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year and the said William Aiter hereby gives and agrees to the said Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year, to wit Corn, Peas, Beans, Peasants, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and also answer as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
