This Agreement made this 1st day of April in the year 1881 between Wm. Sykes of the first part and Beaham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Wm. Sykes is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and it is desired that the said Beaham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Beaham & Turner have agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said Beaham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Wm. Sykes during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of one hundred dollars ~~dollars~~ in amount) as may be needed to enable the said Wm. Sykes to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Wm. Sykes hereby gives and grants to the said Beaham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, etc. Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873, entitled as follows: this 1st day of April 1881.

This Agreement made this 30th day of April in the year 1881 between L. P. Simmons of the first part and Beaham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said L. P. Simmons is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and it is desired that the said Beaham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Beaham & Turner have agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said Beaham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said L. P. Simmons during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of thirty dollars ~~dollars~~ in amount) as may be needed to enable the said L. P. Simmons to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said L. P. Simmons hereby gives and grants to the said Beaham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, etc. Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
