Whereas the said James S. Sumner is engaged in or is about about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Sumner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Sumner have agreed to do. Now this Agreement between them that the said Barham & Sumner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said James S. Sumner during the present year, such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of thirty dollars in amount) as may be useful to enable the said James S. Sumner to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said James S. Sumner hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Sumner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Pumpkins, Cotton and all other crops, in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated.
