

This Agreement made this 3rd day of April for the year 1881 between Prince Boykin of the first part and Burham T. Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Whereas it is further wherein the said Prince Boykin is engaged in business about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and it is desired that the said Burham T. Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Burham T. Turner has agreed to do. Now this agreement contains that the said Burham T. Turner doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Prince Boykin during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies including the sum of \$15.00 after dollars in amount as may be necessary to enable the said Prince Boykin to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Prince Boykin hereby gives and grants to the said Burham T. Turner, a less upon all such crops as he may make in the present year, to wit, Corn, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in arrears to receive the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in accordance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 7th day of April 1881.

Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Burham T. Turner has agreed to do. Now this agreement contains that the said Burham T. Turner doth hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Chas H. Applingwhite during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of \$60.00. Sixty five dollars in amount as may be necessary to enable the said Chas H. Applingwhite to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Chas H. Applingwhite hereby gives and grants to the said Burham T. Turner a less upon all such crops as he may make in the present year, to wit, Corn, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, in arrears to receive the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
