

This Agreement made this 3rd day of April in the year 1881 between Prince Boykin of the first part and Barham & Turner of the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said Prince Boykin is engaged in and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil which the said Barham & Turner have agreed to do. Now this agreement containeth: That the said Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Prince Boykin during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of \$15.00 fifteen dollars in amount as may be useful to enable the said Prince Boykin to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Prince Boykin hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 7th day of April 1881.

Witnesseth as follows: Whereas the said John H. Applewhite is engaged in and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil which the said Barham & Turner have agreed to do. Now this agreement containeth: That the said Barham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said John H. Applewhite during the present year such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding the sum of \$16.50 Sixty five dollars in amount as may be useful to enable the said John H. Applewhite to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said John H. Applewhite hereby gives and grants to the said Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit: Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Beans, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 5th day of April 1881.
