This Agreement made this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year 1871 between Augustus Wiggins of the first part and Burham T. Turner of the other part both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth as follows: Whereas this said Augustus Wiggins is engaged in a field about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Burham T. Turner shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Burham T. Turner has agreed to do. Now this agreement witnesseth, That the said Burham T. Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Augustus Wiggins during the present year such monies free from all taxes and other expenses exceeding the sum of ninety five dollars ~~doles~~ <sup>doles</sup> in amount as may be required to enable the said A. Wiggins to cultivate and gather his crop for rent to the present year. And the said Hugh Wiggins hereby agrees and agrees to the said Burham T. Turner a claim upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit Corn, Peas, Cotton, and all other crops in under lease to secure the payment for all such supplies as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated. This agreement bounded in form of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873.

This Agreement made this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year 1871 between  
Robt. Gricheton of the first part and Barbam & Turner of the other part  
both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth as follows:  
Whereas, the said Robt. Gricheton is engaged in an interest being engaged in the  
cultivation of the soil and it is desired that the said Barbam & Turner shall  
during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivator of  
the soil which the said Barbam & Turner have agreed to do. Now this  
Agreement witnesseth, That the said Barbam & Turner do hereby promise  
and agree to advance and furnish to the said Robt. Gricheton during the  
present year such monies provisions fertilizers and other supplies  
(not exceeding the sum of One hundred & fifty dollars in amount) as  
may be necessary to enable the said Robt. Gricheton to cultivate and carry out  
his crops provided to be made the present year. And the said Robt. Gricheton  
hereby gives and grants to the said Barbam & Turner a lien upon all  
such crops as he may make the present year to wit Corn, Polder, Peas  
Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for  
all such supplies and advances as may be actually made notwithstanding  
the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an Act  
of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873.  
Witnessed and sealed this 25<sup>th</sup> day of March 1871.
