This Agreement made this 5th day of April in the year 1881, between Wm. Colburn
 of the first part, and John D. Turner of the other part, both of the County of
 Southampton State of Virginia. Witness as follows: Whereas, the said Wm.
 Colburn is engaged in, and is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is
 desirous that the said John D. Turner shall during the present year make certain
 advances to the said cultivation of the soil, which the said John D. Turner has agreed
 to do. Now this Agreement is to wit: That the said John D. Turner has agreed
 to do, and agrees to advance and furnish to the said Wm. Colburn during the
 present year, such monies, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding
 the sum of 100 one hundred dollars in amount) as may be needful to enable the
 said Wm. Colburn to cultivate and gather his crops prepared to be made the
 present year. And the said Wm. Colburn hereby gives and grants to the said John
 D. Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year
 to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure
 the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made
 not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of
 an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 2, 1873.

 the other part, both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witness
 as follows: Whereas, the said Nathan & Eld is engaged in, and is about to
 engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous that the said
 Beahm & Turner shall during the present year make certain advances
 to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Beahm & Turner has
 agreed to do. Now this Agreement is to wit: That the said Beahm
 & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to
 the said Nathan & Eld during the present year, such monies, provisions,
 fertilizers and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of twenty five dollars in
 amount) as may be needful to enable the said Nathan & Eld to cultivate
