This Agreement made this 2nd day of April in the year 1874, between Ephraim Crocker of the first part and Becham & Turner of the other part both of the County of Southernmost State of Virginia, of which with as follows. Whereas the said Crocker is engaged in and about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Becham & Turner should during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation of the soil which the said Becham & Turner have agreed to do. Now this Agreement is to wit. That the said Becham & Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Crocker during the present year such money, provision, fertilizer and other supplies (not exceeding the sum of five hundred dollars or less in amount) as may be needed to enable the said Crocker to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said Crocker hereby give and grants to the said Becham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit. Corn Poles, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops in order to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually made not exceeding the sum above stated.
