Act of R. Edwards Lib

This Agreement made this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April in the year 1873 between  
 Ephraim Crocker of the first part and Barham & Turner of the other part  
 both of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth as  
 follows. Whereas the said Ephraim Crocker is engaged in crop about to engage  
 in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous that the said Barham & Turner  
 shall during the present year make certain advances to the said cultivation  
 of the soil which the said Barham & Turner has agreed to do so this  
 Agreement to witness that the said Barham & Turner does hereby  
 promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Ephraim Crocker during  
 the present year such monies as far as may be necessary, fertilizer and other suffic.  
 (not exceeding the sum of one hundred dollars doleure in amount) as  
 may be required to enable the said Ephraim Crocker to cultivate and gather his crops  
 proposed to be made the present year, And the said Ephraim Crocker give  
 and agree to the said Barham & Turner a claim upon all such crops as he  
 may make the present year, Corn, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and other crops as  
 may be actually made, not exceeding the sum above stated, This Agreement  
 is made in consequence of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved
