This Agreement made this 21st day of April in the year 1881 between
Robt Smith (hereinafter called Robt) and Burkham & Turner of the other parts both
of the County of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth whereasm the said
Robt Smith is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and
is desirous that the said Burkham & Turner shall during the present year make
certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said Burkham & Turner
himself holds. Now this agreement witnesseth that the said Burkham & Turner
do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Robt Smith during
the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding
the sum of two hundred (\$200.) dollars in amount as may be necessary to enable
the said Robt Smith to cultivate and gather his crops proposed to be made the
present year. And the said Robt Smith hereby gives and grants to the said
Burkham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present
year to wit Corn, Paddles, Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops in order
to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually
made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance
of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2, 1873.

This Agreement made this 9th day of May in the year 1881 between Wilkeson
Boyle of the first part and Burkham & Turner of the other parts both of the County
of Southampton State of Virginia witnesseth whereasm the said
Wilkeson Boyle in engageth himself is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil
to J. Turner and doth further that the said John J. Turner shall during the present year
make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil which the said John J.
Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement witnesseth that the said John J.
Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said
Wilkeson Boyle during the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers
and other supplies not exceeding the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars in
amount as may be necessary to enable the said Wilkeson Boyle to cultivate
and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year. And the said
Wilkeson Boyle hereby gives and grants to the said John J. Turner a lien
upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit Corn, Paddles,
Peas, Peanuts, Cotton and all other crops, at \$1 by acre & \$1 by horse in order
to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually
made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in
pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved
