This Agreement made this 21st day of April in the year 1873 between
Robt Smith (Caret) of the first part, and Barham & Turner of the other parts, both
of the County of Southampton State of South Carolina. Whereas the said
Robt Smith is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and
it is deemed that the said Barham & Turner shall during the present year make
certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said Barham & Turner
has agreed to do. Now this Agreement is made with that the said Barham & Turner
do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said Robt Smith during
the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers and other supplies not exceeding
the sum of two hundred (200) dollars in amount (as may be made payable to the
said Robt Smith to cultivate any other his crops proposed to be made the
present year, and the said Robt Smith hereby gives and grants to the said
Barham & Turner a lien upon all such crops as he may make the present
year to wit, Corn, Potatoes, Peas, Pumpkins, Cotton and all other crops in order
to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually
made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance
of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved on April 2, 1873.

This Agreement made this 7th day of May in the year 1873 between
Wilkerson Bonds of the first part, and Barham & Turner of the other parts, both of the County
of Southampton State of Virginia. Whereas the said
Wilkerson Bonds is engaged in or is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil,
and it is deemed that the said John D. Turner shall during the present year
make certain advances to the said cultivator of the soil, which the said John D.
Turner has agreed to do. Now this Agreement is made with that the said John D.
Turner do hereby promise and agree to advance and furnish to the said
Wilkerson Bonds during the present year such money, provisions, fertilizers
and other supplies not exceeding the sum of one hundred & fifty dollars in
amount (as may be made payable to the said Wilkerson Bonds to cultivate
and gather his crops proposed to be made the present year, and the said
Wilkerson Bonds hereby gives and grants to the said John D. Turner a lien
upon all such crops as he may make the present year to wit, Corn, Potatoes,
Peas, Pumpkins, Cotton and all other crops, also 1 Bay horse in order
to secure the payment for all such supplies and advances as may be actually
made not exceeding the sum above stated. This Agreement is made in
pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved
April 2, 1873. Witness our hands this 7th day of May 1873.
