This Deed made this 2nd day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty one between John A. McLennan & Anna McLennan his wife of the first part, and John A. Hundley and J. Benson Partlows of the second part, witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of \$1000⁰⁰ this Hundred dollars the said Thomas A. McLennan and Anna McLennan his wife do grant unto the said John A. Hundley and J. Benson Partlows and their heirs forever with general warranty, all their undivided interest in the whole of the Real Estate formerly belonging to Henry A. Gardner of which he died possessed. It is made a condition of this Deed that said John A. Hundley and J. Benson Partlows unto pay all expenses & costs with which said Estate stands charged, except the expense of a suit brought by Thomas A.
