 twenty five dollars out of their portion (half) of the crop, within an hour

 I the said J A Edwards will warrant the title to the said goods to the
 said J E Bailey and his assigns forever from the claims of all
 persons whether or not But it is hereby agreed by the said J E Bailey
 to allow for the period of twelve months the possession of the said
 goods to remain with the said J A Edwards and it is hereby agreed
