This agreement made this 7th day of March 1881 by and between Mr Cornelia
Hunt of the first part and John Burns and Charles Burns of the second part all
of the County of Southampton Virginia witnesseth, the above parties having
entered into an agreement to farm an acre or more for the present year and
that said Burns parties of the second part, so long as sufficient advances
are made to said crop, they the said Burns do agree to pay unto Mr Cornelia Hunt
the party of the first part, the sum thereon advanced (\$25) one hundred and
twenty five dollars out of their portion (half) of the crop, every year and
each day and date above written.

household furniture three red cows two sheep two hens twenty
five bushels of hay & one open buggy I further to have and to hold
the said goods unto the said J E Bailey and his assigns forever And
I the said A E Edwards will warrant the title to the said goods to the
said J E Bailey and his assigns for ever from the date of all
persons whatsoever But it is hereby agreed by the said J E Bailey
to allow for the period of six months no in the possession of the said
goods to remain with the said A E Edwards and it is hereby agreed
