

This Agreement made and entered into this the 16th day of May 1881 between
 J. E. Bailey Esq of the first part and J. A. V. R. A. Brutchlore of the second part,
 Witnesses in force of, that whereas the said J. A. V. R. A. Brutchlore is engaged
 in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies, fertilizers &c
 during the year 1881, from the said J. E. Bailey Esq for the amount of Two hundred dollars
 beyond that amount they shall not go, and the said Bailey Esq having agreed
 to furnish the said supplies, now the said J. A. V. R. A. Brutchlore on their part
 and in consideration of the above advances and promise do hereby grant
 a lien to the said Bailey Esq on all the crops that may be made during the
 year 1881 upon the lands that the said Brutchlore cultivates for the amount
 of the above advances and the cost of this agreement, it is furthermore agreed
 by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to
 the said Bailey Esq by or before the first day of Dec 1881 and in case the
 said crops are not delivered at the time or enough to satisfy this agreement,
 then the said Bailey Esq is hereby empowered to employ labour to take charge
 and gather said crops himself as enough of said crops to satisfy this
 agreement and moreover, it is especially agreed by the parties to this
 agreement that no part of said crops shall be sold, or carried away
 unless it is by and through the consent of said Bailey Esq until this
 agreement is satisfied. This agreement is granted under an act of the
 General Assembly of Virginia approved April 22nd 1873 entitled an
 act to secure redress for agricultural persons

 above advances and promise do hereby grant a lien to the said
 Bailey Esq on all the crops that may be made during the year 1881
 upon the lands that the said Edwards cultivates for the amount
 of the above advances and the cost of this agreement, it is furthermore
 agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be
 delivered to the said Bailey Esq by or before the first day of Dec 1881
 and in case the said crops are not delivered at that time or enough
 to satisfy this agreement, then the said Bailey Esq is hereby empowered
