This Agreement, made and entered into this ^{day} 26th of April 1881, between J E Bailey & Co of the first part and W Pope of the second part, Witnesseth as follows, that whereas the said W Pope is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies, fully or in part, during the year 1881, from the said J E Bailey & Co for the amount of Two hundred & fifty dollars beyond that amount he shall not go, and the said J E Bailey & Co having agreed to furnish the said supplies, now the said W Pope on his part and in consideration of the above recited and promise, do hereby grant a lien to the said J E Bailey & Co on all the crops that may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands that the said W Pope cultivates for the amount of the above advances and the cost of this agreement it is further more agreed by the parties to this agreement that the said crops shall be delivered to the said J E Bailey & Co by or before the 15th day of Nov 1881 and in case the said crops are not delivered at that time or enough to satisfy, the agreement then the said J E Bailey & Co is hereby empowered to employ labor, take charge and gather said crops themselves or enough of said crops to satisfy this agreement and no more, it is especially agreed by the parties to this agreement that no part of said crops shall be sold or carried away unless it is by and through the consent of said J E Bailey & Co until this agreement is satisfied, This agreement is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, of 1870 April 23rd 1873, entitled an act to encourage advances for agricultural purposes.
