This Agreement entered into this 2nd day of May 1881 between W^m M. Beaton trading under the firm name of W^m M. Beaton & Co of one part and James H. Harris Jr of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas the said James Harris Jr engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain during the year 1881 advances in supplies from the said W^m M. Beaton to the amount of Fifty dollars, beyond which limit the said Harris shall not go and the said W^m M. Beaton having agreed on his part to furnish the said advances more the said Jas. Harris Jr on his part in consideration of the above promise do hereby grant a lien to the said W^m M. Beaton on the crops of all kinds which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended.
