This Agreement made this 11th day of May 1881 between Sumner & Beaton merchants of the City of Petersburg and Willis Manning farmer of Southernampton County V^a Witnesses that in consideration of supplies and merchandise to be advanced by said Sumner & Beaton to said Willis Manning during the year 1881 to the amount of and not exceeding the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars; by the said Willis Manning in accordance with section 12, Chapter 87 V. Code of Virginia 1873 hereby gives and constitutes this a special lien on his entire crop of every kind and description to be grown on his farm in said County, during said year 1881 to secure to Sumner & Beaton and their heirs or assigns the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars advanced as aforesaid. Which by the said Willis Manning avows and promises to pay on demand the 1st day of November 1881 and hereby covenants the benefit of Homestead Exemption for the payment thereof. As a further security for the payment of the aforesaid sum of one hundred & twenty dollars and in consideration of five dollars in hand paid to said Willis Manning hereby being and can sell unto Sumner & Beaton the following property to be delivered to them as their order on the 1st day of November 1881 any and every thereafter demanded until which time I reserve the possession of said property and claim from said Sumner & Beaton within the foregoing signature and seal the day and year first aforesaid.
