This Deed made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord Eight hundred & Eighty one, between Saml. H. Barham & Martha his wife of the first part and Wm. Barber of the second part, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said Samuel H. Barham & Martha his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, sell, release, convey, confirm, ratify, and the gentled warranty to the said Wm. Barber party of the second part, of his heirs forever all that certain tract of land upon which the said Saml. H. Barham now resides, lying on the Three Cuckers and Buccoon more or less and containing by old survey, 462 1/2 acres, be the same, however more or less and adjoining the lands of W. B. Westbrook, and others, with the following signatures & seals.
