Barham & Martha his wife, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do grant, bargain, sell, release, quit, confirm, ratify, amend, warrant, to the said Woolly Barham party of the second part, & his heirs forever all that certain tract of land upon which the said Saml. H. Barham now resides, lying on the Three Creeks and Recovers more or less and adjoining by old survey, 462 1/2 acres, by the same however more or less and adjoining the lands of W. B. Westbrook, and others, with the following signatures & seals.
