This Deed, made and entered into this 23rd day of February, in the
year 1851 between J. H. Gardner of the County of Southampton and
State of Virginia party of the first part, and J. D. Pittsor of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia party of the second part.
Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and
Fifty dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
as received to be paid by the party of the second part to the party of the
first part, the said J. H. Gardner granted, bargained, sold and
conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey
with general warranty, unto the said J. D. Pittsor the following
property, to wit: All of his the said Gardner's interest in that tract
piece of land situate lying and being in the County of
Southampton State of Virginia and bounded and described as
follows on the North by the lands of Reb. Edwards and Elisha
Liver, on the east by the land of Joel Council's estate, on the South by
Black Creek running, and on the west by Bradshaws mill run and
the land of said Reb. Edwards, it being the undivided interest of
said J. H. Gardner in said land before going to his late father George
H. Gardner deceased said interest being one undivided fifth
of said land and consisting of about 80 acres of said property above
described the whole property containing by estimation 400
acres more or less, together with all and singular the improvements
and appurtenances belonging to the same. The party of the first
part covenants that he has the right to convey the said land
that he has done no act encumbered the same that the grantee
shall have quiet possession of the said land free from all
encumbrance, and that the said party of the first will
execute such further assurances of the said land as may be
