corn, Potash, Peas, Pease, cotton and all other Crops in  
order to secure the payment for all such surplus and  
advances as may be advanced, made not exceeding the sum  
above stated. This Agreement is made in pursuance of an  
Act of the General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 3<sup>rd</sup>

This Agreement made and entered into this 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1881  
between W. A. Myrick of the first part and W. S. R. H. Bishop of  
the other part, Witnesseth as follows, that whereas the said  
W. S. R. H. Bishop is about to engage in the cultivation of the  
soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1881  
from the said W. A. Myrick for the amount of ninety dollars  
beyond which amount the said W. S. R. H. Bishop shall not  
goe and the said W. A. Myrick having an his part agreed to  
furnish said supplies, Now the said W. S. R. H. Bishop on this  
part and in consideration of the above provisions doth grant  
a lien to the said W. A. Myrick on all the crops which may be  
raised during the year 1881 upon the lands of which the said  
W. S. R. H. Bishop cultivates for the above amount of advances  
which has been or is intended to have been expended, now it is  
further agreed by the parties to this agreement the said W. A.  
Myrick shall be first paid and satisfied after which the balance  
if any shall be paid over to the said W. S. R. H. Bishop. This lien  
is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia  
Approved April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1873 enacted to secure the advances
