This Agreement made and entered into this 27th day of May 1881 between Wm. A. Myrick of the first part and Wm. T. R. M. Bishop of the other part, Witnesseth and forever that whereas the said Wm. T. R. M. Bishop is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1881 from the said Wm. A. Myrick for the amount of ninety dollars beyond which amount the said Wm. T. R. M. Bishop shall not get of the said Wm. A. Myrick having on his part agreed to furnish said supplies, Now the said Wm. T. R. M. Bishop on this part and in consideration of the above provisions doth grant a lien to the said Wm. A. Myrick on all the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands of which the said Wm. T. R. M. Bishop cultivates for the above amount of advances which has been or was intended to have been expended now or is further agreed by this parties to this agreement the said Wm. A. Myrick shall be first paid and satisfied after which the balance if any shall be paid over to the said Wm. T. R. M. Bishop. This Lien is granted under a act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 2/73 entitled an act to secure the advances for agricultural purposes. Witness the foregoing signatures
