Whereas Henry Blox of Southampton County, Virginia is
 engaged in the cultivation of the soil during the year 1881 in and
 upon a certain tract of land lying in the County of Southam-
 pton and being the property of Geo E Hill a citizen and citizen of
 Southampton County, Virginia, hath agreed to advance to the said
 Henry Blox in money or supplies not exceeding in the whole the
 sum of County five dollars, which money or supplies is intended
 to be expended and used in the cultivation of the said tract of land
 of land for which money or supplies so advanced by the said Geo
 E Hill shall be entitled to a lien according to law on the crops
 which may be made by the said Henry Blox on the said tract of
 land during the year aforesaid, Now, this tract mentioned between
 the said Geo E Hill of the one part, and the said Henry Blox of the
 other part, witnesseth that it is agreed between the said parties
 the said Geo E Hill shall make advances of money or supplies
 to the said Henry Blox in such sums and at such times as he may
 demand and require not exceeding in the whole the sum of County five
 dollars, which is intended to be expended and used in the cultivation
 of the tract of land aforesaid and which the said Henry Blox
 for himself and his heirs agrees to repay to the said Geo E Hill an
 ear before the first day of January 1882 with lawful interest on the
 said several advances from the time when they were respectively
 made, until payment. And it is further agreed by and between the
 said parties, that the said Geo E Hill shall be entitled to a lien
 according to the statute in that case made and provided, to the
 extent of the advances which he shall make as aforesaid to the said Henry
 Blox on all the crops which may be made by the said Henry Blox
 on the said tract of land of land during the year aforesaid,
 Witness the hands and seals of the said parties the 31st day of May
 1881.
