Whereas Henry Blore of Southampton County, Virginia is engaged in the cultivation of the soil during the year 1881 in and upon a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and being the property of Geo. & Will and the said Geo. & Will of Southampton County, Virginia, hath agreed to advance to the said Henry Blore in money as supplies, not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seventy five dollars, which money as supplies is intended to be expended and used in the cultivation of the said tract or parcel of land for which money as supplies so advanced by the said Geo. & Will he is to be entitled to a lien according to law, and the crops which may be made by the said Henry Blore on the said tract or parcel of land, during the year aforesaid. Now this deed made between the said Geo. & Will of the one part, and the said Henry Blore of the other part, witnesses such that it is agreed between the said parties that the said Geo. & Will shall make advances of money as supplies to the said Henry Blore in such sums and at such times as he may demand and require not exceeding in the whole the sum of Seventy five dollars, which is intended to be expended and used in the cultivation of the tract or parcel of land aforesaid and which the said Henry Blore for himself and his heirs agrees to repay to the said Geo. & Will within before the first day of January 1882, with the law of interest on the said several advances from the time when they were respectively made until payment. And it is further agreed by and between the said parties, that the said Geo. & Will shall be entitled to a lien according to the statute in that case made and provided, to the extent of the advances which he shall make as aforesaid to the said Henry Blore on all the crops which may be made by the said Henry Blore on the said tract or parcel of land, during the year aforesaid, Witnesses the hands and seals of the said parties, this 31st day of May 1881.
