This agreement entered into this 28th Day of May 1881 between E. G.
Joyner of the first part and Avery Whitefield of the other part witnesseth
that whereas the said Avery Whitefield is about to engage in
cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain supplies during the
year 1881 from the said E. G. Joyner for the amount of Forty Dollars
and for taking the aforesaid sum and for according this agreement
and the said E. G. Joyner having on his part agreed to furnish said
supplies to the said Avery Whitefield on his part and in consideration
of the above provisions the said Avery Whitefield grants to the said E. G. Joyner to
pay entire cost of crop and to freely waive any Exemptions as to
the debt or contract for the amount advanced to him this year which
have been or are intended to have been expended and the said Avery
Whitefield binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said crop above
mentioned to E. G. Joyner at his own house by or before the 1st Day of
November 1881 This instrument under an Acknowledgment of the County
of Virginia approved April 24th 1879 entitled an Act to secure the
Borrowers for Agricultural Purposes wherein the following signatures
