This Agreement entered into this 28th day of May 1851 between E. G. Jordan of the first part and Cary Whitfield of the other part contained a provision that whereas the said Cary Whitfield is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1851 from the said E. G. Jordan for the amount of Forty Dollars and for taking the acknowledgment for recording this Agreement, and the said E. G. Jordan has in his part agreed to furnish said supplies, Now the said Cary Whitfield on his part and in consideration of the above provisions do hereby grant and give to the said E. G. Jordan his entire cotton crop and 3 bushels of corn in full and complete satisfaction of this debt as contract for the amount advanced to him this year which has been an year intended to have been expended and the said Cary Whitfield binds himself agreeable to law to deliver said crop above mentioned to E. G. Jordan at New River by or before the 1st day of November 1851. This debt is granted under an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia chapter 24 of 1832 entitled an Act to secure the Attendance for Agricultural Occupations within the foregoing signatures
