

Our Deed made this 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1881, between James L Bishop  
and Mary W Bishop, his wife, of one part and Davis Barrett of the  
other part, to witness, that the said James L Bishop and wife do hereby  
grant and convey with general warranty unto the said Davis Barrett  
and his heirs forever the following parcel of land, in consideration of the  
sum of one hundred and fifteen \$15 dollars receipt of which is hereby  
acknowledged to wit: a certain parcel of land, containing one acre,  
including the buildings thereon, consisting a part of the land belonging  
to Martha K Stephenson, the line commencing at the branch and  
running East up the line between the lands of J A Stephenson and  
said tract to a stake in the yard, then South to the corner at the line  
in front of the building about one chain, then East until even with the  
side of the smoke house, then North to a stake in the corner lot thus  
west to the branch then up the branch to the beginning. And whereas there  
is a deed of trust on said land for the benefit of P D Story and Doctor T  
Myrick, the co-wit of the said tract I Deacon T Myrick to the execution  
of this deed is evidenced by this signature and sealing this deed.
