This Deed made this 10th day of February Eighteen hundred and eighty one
between Richard G. Brigg and Rochette R. Brigg of Queensville County
State of Virginia of the first part and Caroline W. Drury of Southampton
County VA of the second part, Witness for and in consideration of value recd from
John & Delong the son of Mrs. W. Drury on her by gift to Caroline W. Drury
the wife of Mr. W. Drury with the affidavit John & Delong as Justice the
farm situated in Southampton County near Lees Cross Road known as
the Oak Hill farm containing eight hundred & fifty five and three fourth acres more or less
the aforesaid property shall go to Caroline W. Drury and be in her
possession during her natural life, it being her and independent of the
debts and control of her husband. It shall be for her sole use and amen-
ty her husband and independent of any other person she shall enjoy
and receive the issues and profits during her natural life, then the
property conveyed in this deed shall descend to her children by her first
husband, or in default of any right title and interest in said land to
Caroline W. Drury through her Justice John & Delong. Witness the foregoing
signatures and dates this 10th day of February Eighteen hundred and eighty
one.
