This Deed made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of February Eighteen hundred and eighty one  
 year between Richard G. Grigg and Rachele R. Grigg of Greeneville County,  
 State of Virginia of the first part and Caroline W. Drury of Southampton  
 County, Va. of the second part, witness for and in consideration of sum of one hundred  
 dollars John W. Drury the son of Mr. N. Drury given hereby to Caroline W. Drury  
 the wife of Mr. N. Drury with the above said John W. Drury as trustee the  
 farm situated in Southampton County near Drury's a place and known as  
 the Oak Hill farm & contains eight hundred and fifteen half acres more or less  
 The aforesaid property shall go to Caroline W. Drury and be in her  
 possession during her natural life it being further independent of the  
 debts and control of her husband. It shall be for her sole use and man-  
 agement her pleasure are for her sole use and benefit if it goes from the possession of  
 her husband and independent of any other person she shall enjoy  
 and receive the issues and profits during her natural life. Then the  
 property conveyed in this deed shall devolve to her children by her present  
 husband or until such time as all of our right title and interest in said land to  
 Caroline W. Drury through her trustee John W. Drury witness the following  
 signature and witness this 10<sup>th</sup> day February Eighteen hundred and eighty one
