This Deed made and entered into this the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June A<sup>d</sup> 1881  
 between Alexander Knight and Catherine P. Knight, his wife, grantors  
 of the first part and Joseph E. Bailey grantee of the second part. Witness  
 do for ever that for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred  
 and fifty dollars in hand paid to the grantors of the first part by the said  
 J. E. Bailey grantee of the second part, the receipt of which fully they  
 do hereby acknowledge, they the said Alexander Knight and Catherine  
 his wife do grant bargain sell and by these presents convey unto  
 the said J. E. Bailey all that tract or parcel of land lying and being  
 in Southampton County, containing five hundred and thirty six  
 acres, be the same more or less, and bounded on the North by the lands  
 of Lewis Marsh on the East by the estates of Mathew Pope dead, and  
 Heile L. Gray dead, on the South by Beacon Road and on the west by  
 the old Wall's Place now owned by B. W. Waller. Taking the land which  
 was owned by Richard D. Lewis in his life time, to have and to hold the  
 said land first unto and to the grantors of the first part do covenant with  
 the said Joseph E. Bailey that he was legally possessed of said land and  
 will warrant and defend the title against the lawful claims of all
