Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two Dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said party of the first part doth grant sell and convey unto the said party of the second part all of his Crop and growing in the year in which he lived Consisting of Corn Cotton and peanuts all of his farming implements consisting of his harness hoes & also a new bay mare seven days and one Cow to him a hat to hold the aforesaid Crop farming implements hoes hags and Coats him the said R. K. Kitchen trustee his heirs and assigns forever In best witness to secure to Messrs Etheridge and Brooks of the City of Portsmouth the payment of one bond for the sum of \$12.75 bearing date on the 3rd day of June 1881 and negotiable and payable at the Office of the said Etheridge & Brooks in the City of Portsmouth with eight months after date. Myrick do grant and convey with general warranty to the said J. J. Darden to him and his heirs for ever two certain lots or parcels of land situated in the County of Southampton State of Virginia being at Newmans Depot and bounded on the North by the lots of W. A.
