This Deed made this 14th day of June in the year one thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty one between Henry Ashburn & Elmina his wife of the first part and John A Newell & J D Pittlor of the second part witness that in consideration of the sum of \$600 or three hundred Dollars the said Henry Ashburn & Elmina & Ashburn his wife do grant unto the said John A Newell and J D Pittlor their heirs forever with general warranty all of their undivided interest in the land formerly belonging to George H Gardner deceased It is moreover condition of this deed that the said John A Newell & J D Pittlor are to pay all expenses with which the said Estate of George H Gardner deceased stand charged except the expenses are set brought by said Henry Ashburn & Elmina & Esther E Gardner for accrued rent said Newell & Pittlor being released from payment of last named expenses The said Henry Ashburn & Elmina his wife covenant that they have no right to convey the said land to the greatest that they have done no act to encumber the said land that the Grantees shall have quiet possession of the said land free from all encumbrance and that they Henry Ashburn & Elmina his wife parties of the first part will execute such further assurance of the said land as may be requisite
