Beaton & Co having agreed on their part to furnish the said accommodations more the said Jack Kindred on his part in consideration of the above premises do hereby grant a lien to the said Mrs. M. Beaton & Co on the crops which may be made during the year 1881 upon the lands in cultivation of which the above amount of advances has been or was intended to have been expended.
