

This Agreement made this 20th day of May 1881 between J. G. James & Co of the one part and Deacon Williams of the other, Witnesseth that whereas the said Deacon Williams is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and is desirous to obtain advances in supplies from the said J. G. James & Co to the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars by and which limit the said Deacon Williams shall not go, and the said J. G. James & Co having and being bound to furnish such amount of advances to the said Deacon Williams, doth hereby grant a lien to the said J. G. James & Co on all the crops which during the year 1881 upon the land in cultivation of which the said amount of advances was intended to have been expended. This lien is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia Approved April the 2^d A.D. 1873 entitled an act to secure advances for agricultural purposes. Witness the following signatures,

Whereas Jordan Harris of Southampton County is engaged in the cultivation of the soil and desires to obtain during the year 1881 advances in supplies to the amount of one hundred and fifty dollars and whereas P. S. Thomas of said County doth hereby agree to furnish him to an amount not exceeding said sum of one hundred fifty dollars more therefore this agreement made this 27th day of May 1881 between said Harris and said Thomas witnesseth that the said Harris does hereby give and grants to the said Thomas a lien on all crops which may be grown by the said ~~J. G. James~~ Harris in 1881 to secure payment for the advances so furnished as provided in Chapter 303 of an Act of the General Assembly of 1873-3. The said Harris further agrees to deliver to the said Thomas as his advances soon as possible after said crops are harvested thereof shall have been raised as much of said crops as may at first or from time to time be sufficient to pay for the advances of which witness our signatures and seals this day and year first above written.
