

Now therefore this deed meets this 16th day of May 1881 between the said A M Simmons of the one part & Remmie Turner of the other part witnesseth that said A M Simmons doth grant unto said Remmie Turner his house & all his crop of Cotton Peanuts com'g & folder together with all his interest payable by his several tenants and of this crop of Cotton Peanuts com'g & folder to be made on his farm during the year 1881 in trust to secure said R P Allenan & J J Turner from all loss & damages by reason of the non delivery of the security ship aforesaid. And it is provided that said house shall remain in the possession of said A M Simmons to be used by him as he may see fit until default be made in the payment of said two hundred Dollars with interest as any part thereof for which said bond was given as aforesaid upon such default being made said said Bond after advertisement of time & place of sale for twenty days at the Court House door or some other public place in County shall proceed to sell in the town of Southampton, or some Court day at public auction for cash to the highest bidder said house. And it is covenanted that said crop hereby consigned as so much as may be necessary to pay said note & interest shall be delivered at the store of Beulah & Turner in Southampton unless otherwise directed by written agreement between said A M Simmons & R P Allenan & J J Turner. And the proceeds of sale applied according to the law provided in such cases by sec 6th ch 113 Code 1873. So witness the foregoing signature that this,

This loan is granted under an act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved April 3rd 1873 entitling an act to encourage agriculture and for agricultural purposes contains the following signatures,
